 - Overview of the new [US National Institutes of Health \(NIH\) Data Management and Sharing Policy](#), effective in January 25, 2023.
 - Context & motivation of the new policy: promoting good sharing practices
 - This new policy updates the NIH 2003 Data Sharing policy and the 2014 Genomic Data Sharing Policy is also rolled into the new Data Sharing policy
 - Researchers need to submit a DMS plan (Data Management and Sharing plan).
 - Researchers can provide justification re: why they can't share data sets.
 - Plan should be no longer than 2 pages; NIH is putting out a template.
 - UCI Libraries can assist in identifying repositories.
 - Look for repositories that promote FAIRness of data.
 - Costs - Libraries can provide some assistance re: how much repositories may cost
 - Question: preservation of data is usually in perpetuity - how does this match with the concept of their being "costs?"
 - Costs = can be related to the cost of this work during the award period.
 - Also, researchers pay an upfront cost to have a repository host the data, that pays for housing data for

however long is agreed upon with the repository. Cost of maintaining data in a repository is not an ongoing cost, but usually paid upfront..

- Question: is there a need to retrospectively share data?
 - Wasila hasn't seen a need/requirement for sharing data from studies/research pre-January 2023.
- Question: Should we rename the Library committee given that libraries no longer are just print materials. Some people assume libraries are no longer needed because most information is now available online?
 - Renaming may not make sense at this point, but the question raises the point that we need to redefine and better share what it is that libraries do.
- Question: how is this information about the policy being communicated to the School of Medicine? What role is DSS playing in communicating this information?
 - Wasila is giving a seminar and DSS is planning some outreach activities.
 - Research Insider - provide information through that – reaches SoM?
 - Agreed that information to Communication Officers at the Schools so that they can share out with their faculty, students, researchers.
- Question: is there a boilerplate that helps people understand what is needed in the DMP?
 - Yes, a group worked on one this summer and there is a new template in DMP that is being updated as NIH provides more information.

 - Report on health sciences collections strategy for the current fiscal year
 - 3% cut in the budget. The UCI Libraries still don't know exactly how this impacts collections, but they are approaching the year with the idea that the collections budget will be flat.
 - Good news: we have access to Clinical Key, from Elsevier.
